Dear Sir

Your email has been passed to me as the partner in charge of the Fast Track Division of Lester Aldridge.

The position is as follows:

1. A court order was made on 10 February requiring that you pay instalments of £100 payable on directly to Toyota Financial Services by 28th day of each month commencing 28 February.
2. The last payment received from you was in September.
3. According to our records you made 10 payments of £100 since 28 February received on the following dates

22/03/2005	100.00
23/03/2005	100.00
25/04/2005	100.00
24/05/2005	100.00
24/06/2005	100.00
25/07/2005	100.00
25/08/2005	100.00
23/09/2005	100.00

Total	£800.00

4. In fact 10 months' payments are due for every month since 28th February including 28th November, a total of £1000.
5. You are therefore in default by 2 months' instalments, a total of £200.

I therefore cannot see that there can be any question of this firm harassing you. It is not harassment to request payment of moneys which you have been ordered by the court to pay.

Dear Mr Corke

Although Lester Aldridge may like to think they, as a company, are beyond rebuke or criticism, I would have expected the man who is in charge of the Fast Track Division – a commercial litigator and graduate of Bristol University, no less – to be a little more intelligent than you appear to be.

In my email below, I made it perfectly clear that I could prove I had made payments in October and November yet you continue to accuse me of non-payment and of defaulting on the court's orders. I therefore have to advise you that you have made a bad mistake.

As this is not the first time payments made to Toyota have disappeared into some mysterious black hole, I would have expected you to at least question the reliability of their accounts receivable system especially as your own records appear to depend on it. That said, your Mrs Loveless was yesterday claiming that the court order stated I should be making payments directly to Lester Aldridge yet I see this is not the case according to your email below and, indeed, this has now been confirmed by the copy of the judgment forwarded by Mrs Loveless yesterday. Perhaps your staff members have difficulty establishing obvious facts?

As far as I am now concerned, you have not heeded my warning and have now made three written attempts to harass me so please let me outline my intended response.

1. I will not be making any further payment until 28th December 2005 when I will send £100. I have no intention of paying twice merely because you demand it and cannot or will not admit your client's, or your own company's incompetence.
2. I plan to study the copy of the statement provided by Michael Fry via Mrs Loveless as the contents suggest further investigation may be required. Although Mrs Loveless said yesterday that she would obtain an up to date statement from Toyota and post this to me, the copy she has sent is actually dated 22nd November and is presumably the one on which she formulated her demand dated 24th November for missing October and

November payments even though the November payment was not due at that stage. I therefore plan to contact your regulating body and advise them about your true modus operandi.

3. I aim to write an account of my experiences with Toyota Financial Services and Lester Aldridge and publish it on the internet, backed up by selected correspondence as evidence. Hopefully, this will elicit feedback from other people who have suffered similar experiences at your hands and I will publish the results and ensure they are brought to the attention of people who need to understand how your victims are treated.

I have this morning spoken to an official at Dartford Court and advised her of your recent actions and I plan to follow the advice she has recommended. I also feel it is now time to contact the relevant authority about Toyota's abuses of the Data Protection Act using evidence that was inadvertently supplied by Lester Aldridge and I also propose to take other action that you will no doubt learn about in due course. In the meantime, it appears from all your correspondence that you are determined to prove your stupidity so I look forward to defending the enforcement action you have threatened.

I suppose that I should feel complemented that you have taken the trouble to look up my details on our website.

Be that as it may by no stretch of the imagination can a request for payment of arrears be described as harassment.

I attach a copy of the latest statement of account received from Toyota. You will see that no payment has been received in October or November. You are therefore 2 months in arrears. There is a court order providing that our client can seize the vehicle if payments are not made as provided for in the order. Kindly remedy the situation forthwith.

If payment is not made within 7 days we will advise our client to repossess the vehicle.
